

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER No. **94-14**

**IN RE: APPROVAL OF THE SOUTH FLORIDA TRAFFIC SCHOOL INC.'S
PILOT PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the Chief Judge of the Circuit may designate driver improvement schools in cases where defendants are ordered to attend pursuant to Section 316.655, Florida Statutes and Rule 6.110 of the Florida Rules of Traffic Court; and

WHEREAS, South Florida Traffic School Inc.'s four (4) hour traffic course entitled "USA Driving Safety Course" has obtained provisional approval from the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles; and

WHEREAS, under the laws of the State of Florida, this course must undergo a pilot test in order to ascertain its effectiveness and to complete an impact study; and

WHEREAS, South Florida Traffic School Inc. has requested the required approval of the Chief Judge of this Circuit to conduct the requisite pilot program in the Eleventh Judicial Circuit;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LEONARD RIVKIND, pursuant to the authority vested in me, hereby approve South Florida Traffic School Inc.'s offering of its course entitled "USA Driving Safety Course" in the Eleventh Judicial Circuit exclusively for the purpose of conducting the requisite pilot program.

This Order is subject to rescission and withdrawal at any time without reason and without giving reason therefore.
