**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
NO. 99-14 A 1  
(Amending AO 99-14)**

**IN RE: AMENDING THE  
CRITERION FOR ATTENDING THE  
EIGHT (8) HOUR INTERMEDIATE  
DRIVER IMPROVEMENT COURSE**

---

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Administrative Order No. 99-14, dated May 24, 1999, individuals who do not qualify for an election under Section 318.14(9), Florida Statutes, in lieu of court appearance, were authorized to elect to attend an eight (8) hour intermediate driver improvement course upon payment of the course's tuition and court costs equal to the statutory civil penalty which is applicable when one elects to attend the four (4) hour basic improvement course; and

**WHEREAS**, such individuals were entitled to attend an eight (8) hour intermediate driver improvement course only one time ever, unless such attendance is expressly authorized by individual court order; and

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined that this criterion should be amended to exclude individuals who hold a Commercial Driver License;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Chief Judge of the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, it is hereby ORDERED that the criterion set forth in Administrative Order No. 99-14 is amended to read as follows:

“A person, who does not hold a Commercial Driver License (CDL), is entitled to attend an eight (8) hour intermediate driver improvement course, hereunder, only one time ever, unless such attendance is expressly authorized by individual court order.”

This Order shall take effect immediately upon execution and shall remain in effect until further order of the court.
