**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

**IN RE: CREATION OF SECTIONS HI
04 AND HI 05 IN THE COUNTY CIVIL
DIVISION OF THE ELEVENTH
JUDICIAL CIRCUIT OF FLORIDA**


WHEREAS, inasmuch as the number of incoming Summary Procedure (SP) cases assigned to each judge in the County Civil Division has significantly increased, the Court has determined that in the interest of effecting the prompt disposition of cases, two (2) additional judicial sections must be created in the County Civil Division.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Chief Judge of the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, under Rule 2.215, Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, it is hereby **ORDERED**:

1. Effective February 1, 2021, Sections HI 04 and HI 05 are created in the County Civil Division.
2. The assignment and/or reassignment of the newly filed Summary Procedure (SP) cases shall be accomplished under the blind filing system historically utilized in making such assignments and reassignments, or any similar method which will result in such cases being filed at the Hialeah Court location, in Sections HI 01, HI 04, and HI 05 of the County Civil Division.
3. Any inequities in caseload distribution among the sections of the County Civil Division will be adjusted by the Administrative Judge.

This Administrative Order shall take effect on February 1, 2021, *nunc pro tunc*, and shall remain in effect until further order of the Court.
