AND COUNTY COURT CRIMINAL
DIVISIONS AND THE PROBATE AND
GUARDIANSHIP DIVISION FOR THE
CALENDAR YEAR COMMENCING ON
JANUARY 1, 2021**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Administrative Order No. 12-21, as amended, certain judicial officers were designated to hear and determine motions to exceed the fee limits filed by court appointed counsel, in accordance with section 27.5304(12)(b), Florida Statutes (“Motions”); and


WHEREAS, heretofore, the designations were made based on a quarterly rotational basis within a calendar year unless a designated judge was unable to perform his/her duties thereby necessitating the designation of a substitute judge; and

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Chief Judge of the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, under Rule 2.215, Rules of Judicial Administration, it is hereby **ORDERED**:

1. The **HONORABLE MARISA TINKLER MENDEZ** is hereby designated to hear and determine motions to exceed the fee limits filed by court appointed counsel in the Circuit and County Court Criminal Divisions and the Probate and Guardianship Division (“Motions”) for such Motions scheduled to be heard in the first quarter beginning on or about January 1, 2021 through March 31, 2021, and the third quarter beginning on or about July 1, 2021 through September 30, 2021.
2. The **HONORABLE MIGUEL DE LA O**, is hereby designated to hear and determine such Motions scheduled to be heard in the second quarter beginning on or about April 1, 2021 through June 30, 2021, and the fourth quarter beginning on or about October 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021.
3. Said quarterly rotations by the Judges designated herein shall continue until further order of the Court.

4. Except as herein amended, Administrative Order 12-21, as amended, remains in full force and effect until further order of the Court.
