**IN RE: REASSIGNMENT OF
FORMER SECTION 50 CASES
AND REOPENING REQUIREMENTS**

SUBSEQUENT TO THE CONCLUSION OF THE FORECLOSURE AND ECONOMIC RECOVERY PROGRAM AND CLOSURE OF FORMER SECTION 50, there has been recent post-judgment filing activity in foreclosure cases closed in Section 50. In the interests of the Judicial Administration of the Eleventh Judicial Circuit, it is necessary to implement procedures for the management of these former Section 50 cases.

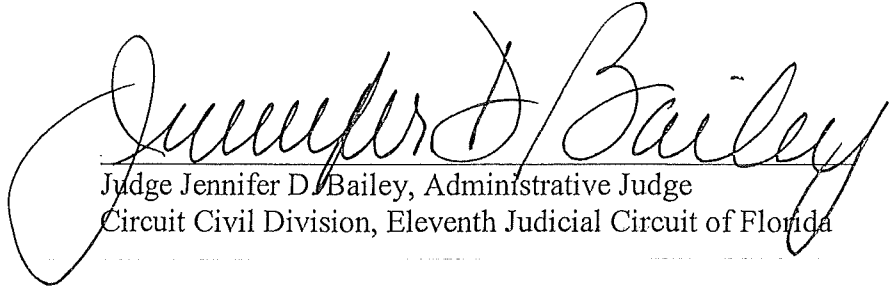
NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the authority vested in me as Administrative Judge of the Circuit Civil Division in the Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida, under Rule 2.215, Florida Rules of Judicial Administration, utilizing the limited court resources available, these cases shall be managed as follows:

1. All former Section 50 cases, whether open or closed, shall be assigned to the following Judicial Sections:

A. 40	Judge Gill Freeman
B. 42	Judge Joseph P. Farina
C. 58	Judge Michael Genden
D. 59	Judge Ellen Leesfield
2. The reassignment of the former Section 50 foreclosure cases shall be accomplished under the blind filing system historically used by the Clerk of the Circuit Court in making such assignments to achieve an equitable distribution.
3. The Clerk of the Court is hereby directed and authorized to execute this reassignment.
4. The reassignment of the subject cases does not affect the closed status of a case. A party must comply with reopening requirements prior to filing of any motion.

This Administrative Memorandum shall take effect on July 20, 2011, and shall remain in effect until further order of the Court.
