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**ORDER WAIVING RESTRICTED DEPOSITORY REQUIREMENTS
FOR SOCIAL SECURITY BENEFITS**

On the petition of _____, as the Guardian for the above named Ward, for waiver of the restricted depository requirements for the Ward’s Social Security Benefits, the Court finds that good cause exists for the waiver of such restriction as they are the Ward’s sole known asset/income, and the Ward’s Guardian is the representative payee for these benefits. It is therefore ADJUDGED that:

1. The restricted depository requirement is waived as to Social Security Benefits only.
2. A restricted depository shall be required if, and when, any other assets/incomes of the Ward are discovered by the Guardian.
3. The Guardian shall timely file all required annual reports; however, if Social Security Benefits are the Ward’s only asset/income, the Guardian may file an Annual Memorandum to the Clerk in lieu of an annual accounting as required under §744.3678 F.S..
4. If any other asset or income of the Ward is discovered, the Guardian must file an annual accounting in accordance with §744.3678 F.S., which shall account for all of the Ward’s assets and incomes, including the Ward’s Social Security Benefits.
