

# HOUSING FOR HOMELESS INDIVIDUALS IN MIAMI-DADE



Secure emergency, transitional, and permanent options if you are struggling with your housing or facing homelessness.

When to Apply: No deadline, on-going program

## You should apply if you

- Live in Miami-Dade County.
- Are in need of safer or more stable housing.
- Are you living in a place not meant for human habitation or are you a youth age 18-24 and do not have a stable place to live.
- Attempting to flee domestic violence or human trafficking.

## How to get started

1

If living in an unstable place, after selecting the language of your choice, press option #5. If you live on Miami Beach (only) press option #4. If attempting to flee domestic violence or human trafficking press option #2.

3

You'll be connected to a trained specialist. You can tell them what you need help with.

4

The specialist will connect you to the services available to you.

## Information you'll need to provide

Requested information will depend on the services you are being connected to. You will likely need to provide the following:

- Photo ID like a driver's license or passport.
- Proof of homelessness. This could be a letter from a homeless prevention program, or a court filed eviction.
- A way to show that you are facing hardship. This could be a late payment notice on rent or a disconnection of your utilities.

## Helpful tips

If you need help with anything housing related, reach out. This service can help with rent, utility payments, security deposits, legal assistance, and credit counseling.

Call during working hours. The homeless helpline is open Monday - Friday from 8 am - 5 pm.
