


STANDING ORDER FOR DIVISION 05 CONCERNING TELEPHONIC APPEARANCE

THIS COURT, on its own Motion, hereby enters this Standing Order that shall be applicable to all hearings in this division that are scheduled for 15 minutes or less. This Standing Order shall remain effective until further Order from this Court. It is hereby,

ORDER AND ADJUDGED:

1. This Court will no longer enter orders permitting any party, or counsel of any party, to appear by telephone.
2. Any party, or counsel of any party, that wishes to appear by phone shall file a Notice of Telephonic Appearance. The Notice shall clearly provide the date of the hearing, the motion(s) to be heard and a direct line where the Court can reach the party, or counsel, appearing by phone. **Strict compliance is required.**
3. It is the sole responsibility of the person choosing to appear by telephone to ensure that the Notice of Telephonic Appearance is filed with sufficient time for it to appear on the Court's docket by the date and time of the hearing.
4. If the Notice of the Telephonic Appearance is not reflected on the Court's docket at the time of the hearing, and if the party and/or counsel is not present at the hearing, they will be deemed to have failed to appear.
5. Any party, or counsel, that has chosen to appear by phone must be available, at the direct line provided, for at least 90 minutes following the hearing's start time.
6. Do not call Chambers to inquire as to whether the Notice of Telephonic Appearance is reflected on the Court's docket.
7. This Order shall not apply to Pre-Trial Conferences.
