

CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER

THIS CAUSE came before the Court for an Initial Case Management Conference pursuant to the Court's Notice and Order. All counsel and the parties were present, in-person or remotely. After reviewing the Joint Case Management Report, with the stipulation of the Parties to the trial date set forth below and being otherwise fully informed, it is **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** as follows: The parties are directed to comply in all respects with the Court's Division Procedures and Complex Business Litigation Rules located at: [Javier Enriquez - Eleventh Judicial Circuit of Florida](#)

Courtesy copies of all motions and memoranda shall be submitted as directed on each judge's web page.

Unless later modified by Order of this Court, the attached Case Management Schedule shall control the management and proceedings in this case.

It is further **ORDERED** that the setting of the discovery deadline will not limit any party from filing summary judgment motions during the discovery period, but any such motions should be narrowly drawn to address only issues on which discovery has been completed, and upon issues where there is no outstanding *material* discovery. If there are still motions pending after the completion of the discovery period, the Court will set a briefing schedule at that time.

In all respects, the presumptive limitations on discovery contained in the Complex Business Litigation Rules shall apply.

Plaintiff shall advise the Court of the precise date of mediation no later than five (5) days prior. Plaintiff is **ORDERED** to advise the Court, in writing, of the outcome of the mediation no later than five (5) days following the conclusion of the mediation conference.

Pursuant to Florida Rule of Civil Procedure 1.201 (b)(3): “Continuance of the trial of a complex action should rarely be granted and then only upon good cause shown. Any motion for continuance will be governed by rule 1.460.”

In the event that any party files a petition for writ of certiorari or a notice of appeal during the course of the proceedings which would divest this Court of its jurisdiction over the action and/or the parties thereto, the movant shall provide the Court with a copy of same in order to advise the Court that such a proceeding has been commenced, as well as the disposition of same.

This Court requires that a person with full authority to settle the case be present at trial at all times. Plaintiff(s) shall therefore have a person present at trial who has the ability, without consulting any other person(s), to settle the claim. Defendant(s), and any insurance carrier providing a defense (whether doing so under a reservation of rights or not), shall have a representative present at trial who has the complete authority, without consulting any other person(s), to accept the most recent pre-trial demand of Plaintiff(s) or, absent such a demand, authority to settle the case for the full amount of the claim. This requirement will not, under any circumstances, be waived. Those with authority as defined herein shall be present commencing on the first day of jury selection and at all times during trial.
